DESCRIPTION OF STUDY:

My goal is to complete a six-month course to become a Certified Life Coach. The program is accredited through the International Coach Federation (IFC https://coachingfederation.org), and upon completion I will have earned a professional credential.

The program addresses all aspects of life coaching from theory to practical application. The certification includes understanding techniques and strategies associated with health and wellbeing. For example, course work includes strategies on goal setting, listening, journaling, life evaluation and gratitude. It also focuses on personal growth in relation to values and beliefs.

The course includes 30 in-class hours with a cohort of 10-12 people. There is an additional 60 hours of self-study and homework.

The curriculum includes:

- Coaching from the Center (value, vision, and relationships)
- Effective Coaching Tools (listening, powerful questioning techniques, responding intuitively)
- Masterful Coaching (artful coaching, empowerment, dealing with challenges)

PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT:

As an English 1AS instructor and a member of FYE faculty, it is necessary to support my students using a holistic approach. College students are suffering from depression and anxiety at unprecedented levels. In the article "Trauma and Social Anxiety are Growing Mental Health Concerns for College Students," Kate Marijolovic shares the results of a recent study conducted by Brett Scofield at Penn State that examined data from 180 colleges and included nearly 200,000 students. The results published in the January 2023 issue of *The Chronical of Higher Education* reports that "the number of students experiencing social anxiety increased significantly from 2021 to 2022, and it was the psychological symptom with the greatest change over the past 12 years. Cases of depression and generalized anxiety have also risen steadily for the past decade. Scofield said increased social-media usage and the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic and students returning to in-person learning may have contributed to marked rise in social anxiety." The article then shares that Scofield's "findings show that counseling services are essential to student retention."

These findings, and additional research, are consistent with my experience in the classroom. My students need more than academic support to thrive. In a perfect world, we would provide individual counseling intervention for all students. Unfortunately, that is unrealistic. My pedagogy currently employs readings, exercises, and strategies to help students build confidence and community, but I know that I can infuse more into the classroom to promote health and wellness, and ultimately impact student success and retention.

DESCRIBE HOW IT WILL INCREASE PROFICIENCY IN APPLICANT'S FIELD:

Gaining a life coaching certification will provide professional training that can be immediately employed in the classroom. It will allow me to infuse life-skills more thoroughly into the curriculum to positively impact all students directly and effectively. Creating this type of environment will have an even greater impact on underrepresented student populations who disproportionately suffer from imposter syndrome, depression, and anxiety and are less likely to seek outside support. Being a trained specialist will support El Camino's goal to close the current equity gaps that exist.

In addition to a Masters in English, I currently hold a Masters in Counseling. Having this degree has informed my pedagogy and increased my effectiveness in the classroom. A certificate in life coaching will compliment my current educational achievements and increase my effectiveness by providing hands-on strategies that are most effective in the classroom environment.
