

Police Advisory Committee Meeting  
August 20, 2014

Since there was not enough members to make a quorum this meeting is an informational meeting.

The start of fall semester is this Saturday, however, Monday, August 25 will be the first day with the majority of the students attending. Staff and faculty should arrive early. Heavy student traffic starts around 9 am to 9:15 am. More students are staying longer on campus which also impacts parking.

Students are accommodated during the first two weeks of the semester. They are allowed to park in unmarked stalls where emergency lanes or fire hydrants are not blocked. Students who park in staff stalls will be cited.

Phillip inquired about charging stations for electric vehicles. At the present time, the district does not have designated charging stations.

There is a vacant police officer position at El Camino Compton Educational Center campus. They are in the process of hiring an officer. El Camino Torrance campus is in the process of filling the vacant sergeant's position.
