- Fall fees were paid! However, second 8-week courses were in the process of being paid the week of November 11.
- Changes to processing is still in process of changing. What will remain the same is: student must be first time fulltime in the fall, must complete orientation, assessment, educational plan + financial aid application. The priority deadline of April 30 will be promoted. The goal is to not ask potential students to complete yet another application to access.

### **General Updates**

- November 13 was our annual <u>College Night</u>. We had over 1,166 guests attend. We likely saw more as some individuals refused to check in.
- Attendance and participation was:

  - 301 new registered student voters as tracked by the California Secretary of State placing 11th out of 117 California Community College schools.
  - A perfect score of 234/234 on the Civic and Voter Engagement Action Plan for 2024-2026, with placement from the Secretary of State's office of the plan in the "Exceptional" category
- ASO's three homecoming week events welcomed 616 students to events that promoted spirit and active
  engagement at El Camino.
- ASO has partnered and attended many events across campus in collaboration with Outreach, Student Health Services, and the Veteran's Center.
- Our addition to the well-established Veteran's day event provided food to over 250 people, with our own Valerie Monteverde, Division Council Member of Mathematical Sciences, participating in the ceremony as a 6-year US Navy Veteran.

- A small, but mighty cohort of around 20 students has taken up this program this fall, complementing our first cohort of approximately 30 students, which completed the program last Spring.
