CHILDREN AND THE LIBRARY & LEARNING RESOURCES FACILITIES

To provide for the general welfare of all persons using the Library & Learning Resources' facilities including the Schauerman Library, Library Media Technology Center, Learning Resource Center, Music Library and all division labs, the following policy has been approved:

MAINTAINING THE STUDY ENVIRONMENT

The Library and Learning Resources (LLR) is designed for the use of college-level students and other adults. The LLR staff and faculty cannot be responsible for monitoring children. The LLR maintains an environment conducive to study and research, as such, parents or guardians of children may be asked to leave if children are causing disturbances by crying, running, making noise, or exhibiting other disruptive behavior.

LIBRARY COMPUTER USE

Minors who are not ECC students may not use LLR computers, even with a parent's permission, as computer stations are reserved primarily for ECC student use.

UNATTENDED CHILDREN

Parents or guardians may not send children to any LLR space without uninterrupted supervision given by the parent or guardian. If an unsupervised child is found in the Division's facilities, Campus Police will be notified, and the child will be taken to the Campus Police Office until the parent/guardian can be located.

A written copy of this policy will be given to individuals who do not observe the above policies, when appropriate.
