The Women's History Month Committee is seeking distinguished women from the El Camino College campus and community to honor at this year's Women's History Month Luncheon on March 18, 2020. This year's National Women's History Month theme is "**Valiant Women of the Vote**". The theme celebrates the women who have fought for a woman's right to vote in the United States. In recognition of the centennial of the 19th Amendment, we will honor women who have continued the struggle (fighting against poll taxes, literacy tests, voter roll purges, and other more contemporary forms of voter suppression) to ensure voting rights for all.

The women honored will have their portraits hung in the El Camino College Women's Wall of Fame gallery over the next year, will have their names engraved on a perpetual plaque in the gallery, and will receive a certificate of recognition during the Women's History Month Luncheon.

Please nominate a woman of distinction who has contributed to the ECC and/or larger campus community by writing a brief statement of a few paragraphs to support your nominee. Friends, family, or colleagues may make nominations, or individuals may nominate themselves. Those nominated need only reside or work in the communities within the El Camino College district: El Segundo, Hawthorne, Hermosa Beach, Inglewood, Lawndale, Lennox, Manhattan Beach, Redondo Beach and Torrance.

Nominees will be considered based on their contributions to women and girls' causes or community service that supports this year's National Women's History Month theme: "**Valiant Women of the Vote.**"
