Hiring Steps:

1. Pick up an SI Coach application in MBA 327/329 or download from the El Camino College SI Program webpage.

2. Submit the application in MBA 327/329, along with unofficial transcripts from ECC and/or other colleges attended.

3. Take a course-specific quiz in MBA 327/329 to assess your current knowledge of the course content. This quiz is used to get an idea of your current knowledge of the course you would like to coach. Some folks remember more than others, and that is OK. The grade you get on this quiz does not automatically qualify you nor disqualify you from getting the coaching position. Other factors are taken into considered when selecting SI Coaches.

4. Schedule an interview.

A typical SI Coach work-week involves approximately 8-14 hours, depending on the course:

- 3 to 8 hours attending class lectures/labs.
- 1 to 2 hours planning SI sessions.
- 2 hours facilitating SI sessions.
- 1 hour attending SI staff meeting (6 meetings for the semester).
- $\frac{1}{2}$ hour meeting with course instructor.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Enjoy interacting with other students.
- Have a good understanding of the content in the course you want to coach.
- Be willing to interact with peers, staff, and faculty.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct weekly SI study sessions with your students.
- Assist students with course content and academic development.
- Attend all class lectures.
- Meet with the SI instructor once a week.
