3. Take a quiz in MBA 327/329 in the subject(s) you want to coach in order to assess current knowledge in the course.
4. Schedule an interview in MBA 327/329.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Enjoy interacting with your peers.
- Have a strong understanding of the content in the course you want to coach.
- Be able to communicate clearly and effectively with peers, staff, and faculty.
- Be able to commit to working an average of 7-10 hours per week for the entire semester.
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

RESPONSIBILITIES

A typical work week involves:

- 3 to 5 hours attending class lecture, depending on the course units
 - 1 to 2 hours planning SI sessions
 - 2 hours facilitating SI sessions
 - ½ hour attending SI staff meeting
 - ½ hour meeting with course instructor
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- Assist students with course content and academic development.
 - Attend all class lectures. You will learn instructor expectations while building student rapport.
 - Plan and facilitate two 50 minute SI activity sessions every week for the entire semester.
 - Promote the SI sessions to the class. Effective promotion is essential to increase attendance in the SI sessions.
 - Help students refine learning skills such as note taking, test preparation, problem solving, organization, and group studying.
 - Develop and maintain working partnership with instructor.
 - Attend pre-semester and on-going SI Coach training.
