Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ CA Resident or AB-540 or AB-1899
- Enrolled in at least 12 units when accepted into the EOPS Program
- ✓ Have less than 70 degree applicable units completed
- California College Promise Grant (SBOG- Method A, B, or C with zero EFC). We encourage you to complete the FAFSA or CA Dream Act application

Plus One Educational Need in the Following:

- Not qualified for enrollment in the minimum level
 English or Mathematics course required for an associate
 degree
- ✓ Not have graduated from high school or obtained a GED
- ✓ High School graduate with a GPA below 2.5
- ✓ Previous enrollment in remedial courses
- ✓ Other factors (i.e. first generation college student, primary language spoken at home is not English, foster youth, required to enroll in a supplemental course for English and/or Math)

CARE (Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education) is a supplemental program of EOPS for single head of household parents receiving TANF/CalWORKs.

Additional Requirements (CARE ONLY):

- ✓ You are at least 18 years of age
- You receive CalWORKs/TANF cash aid for yourself **OR** dependent child(ren) as single head of household
