- 1. Pacific Dining was consulted first. A detailed copy of correspondence must be *attached*.
- 2. Leave room in its original condition.
- 3. Outside food service providers must present all requisite permits, licenses and insurance with the following limits (a Certificate of Insurance in an ACORD 25 Form with El Camino College as "Additional Insured").
  - Comprehensive General Liability of \$1 million
  - Workers' Compensation of \$1 million
  - Automobile Liability of \$ 1 million

## Instructions

Pacific Dining, a premier food service and catering company, has partnered with El Camino College to provide the college with the highest quality food services. Pacific Dining's staff utilize a full-service kitchen to provide fresh, high-quality food and services for your special event.

ECC organizations are required to contact Pacific Dining (<u>catering@elcamino.edu</u>) for first consideration before purchasing any food for sale or distribution. If possible, Pacific Dining will work with your group to provide catering. If there are specific reasons why your organization does not wish to use Pacific Dining (budget restrictions, ethnic food, etc.) mention so in the email. If Pacific Dining grants permission for food items to be purchased elsewhere, attach proof of this permission to the Food Service Exemption Form (available in the Student Development Office) and email it to Andy Nasatir (<u>anasatir@elcamino.edu</u>) and the Student Services Technician.

Events with ten (10) people or less and/or food services worth \$50 or less are not required to go through Pacific Dining for first consideration. Organizations falling within this category do not have to contact Pacific Dining or fill out the exemption form; they may go directly to their preferred food vendor and purchase the items needed.

Note that if your food items are store-bought, pre-packaged, and not delivered to ECC by a company or restaurant, copies of the business license, liability insurance, and workers compensation insurance do not need to be attached to the Food Service Exemption Form.
