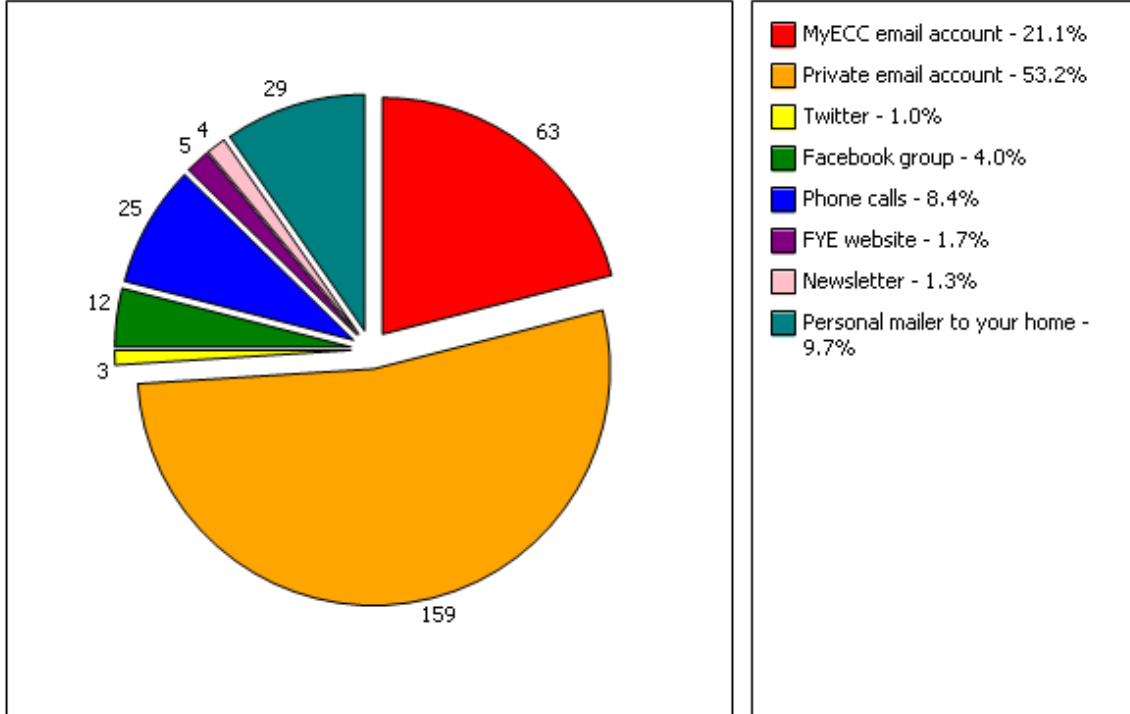

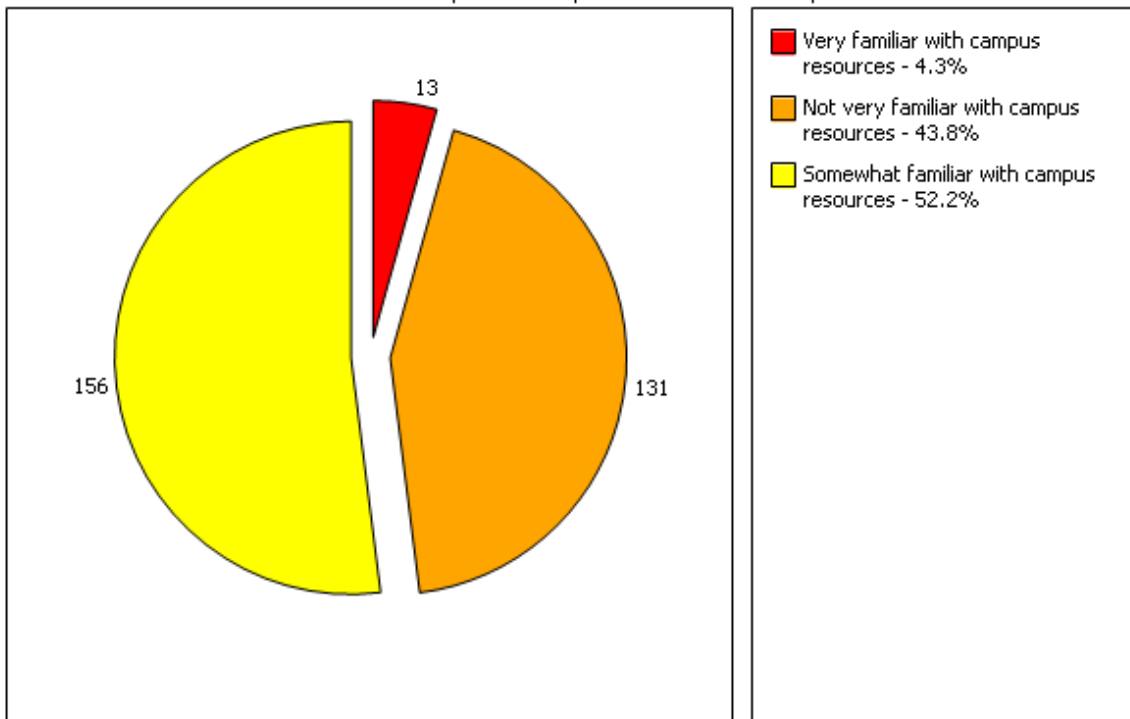

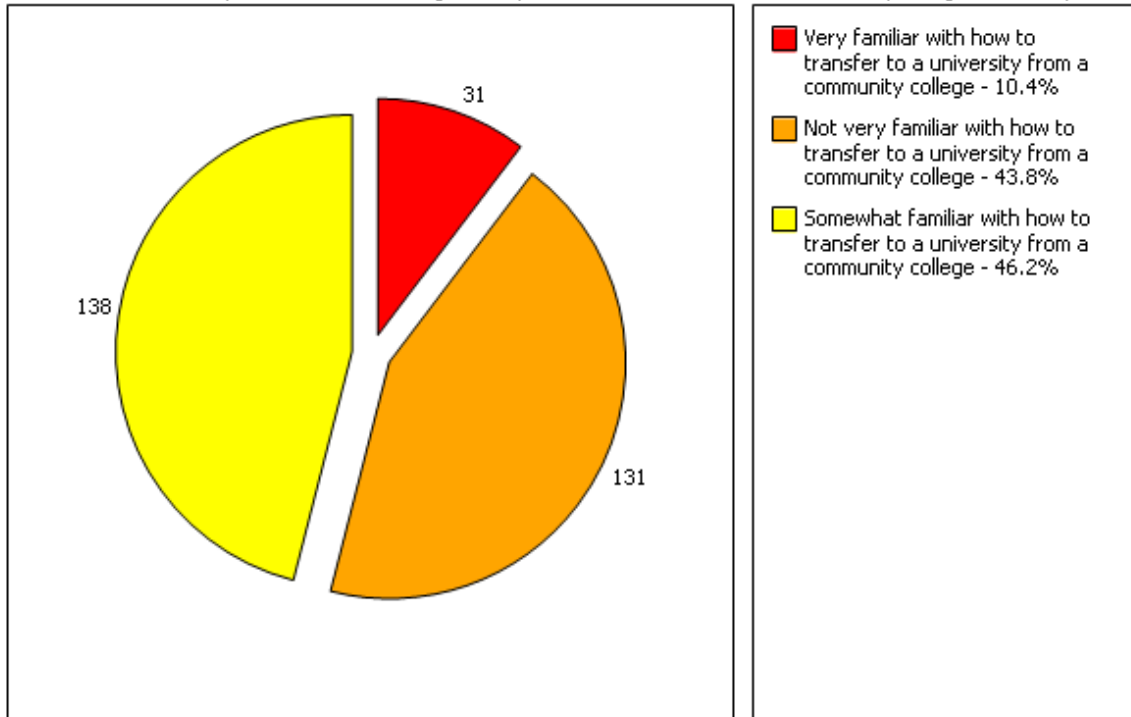
3. How familiar are you with campus resources? - 299 Responses

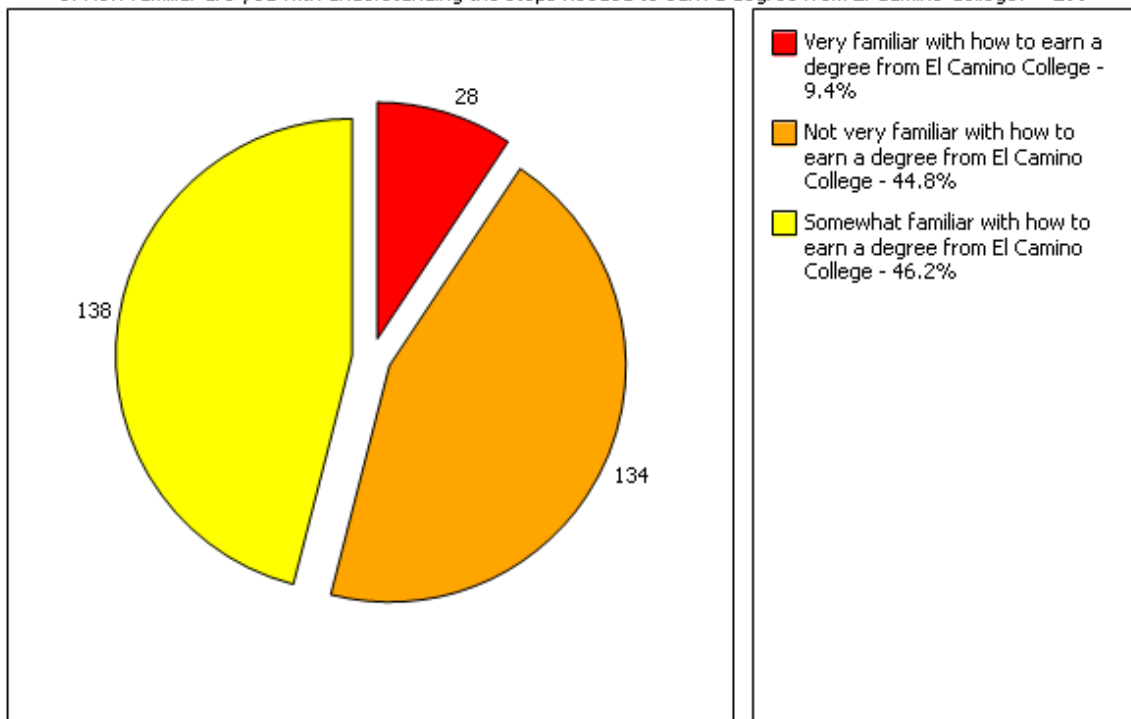
4. How familiar are you with understanding the steps needed to transfer from a community college to a four-year
