AI CERTIFICATE OF ACCOMPLISHMENT

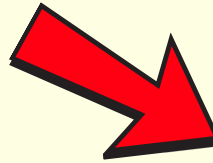
Pending State Approval

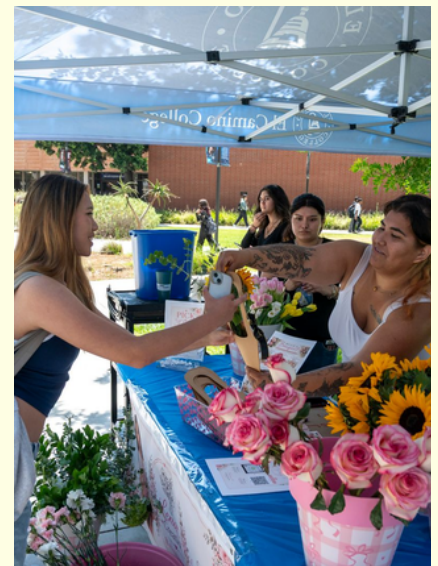

COURSE DESCRIPTION:
This course is a survey of artificial intelligence (AI) where students explore different technologies utilizing concepts and skills widely accepted for AI and digital competency. Classification algorithms, supervised vs. unsupervised learning, data preparation, and training/using learning models for predictions are presented.

We will also use Jupyter Notebooks and Python to learn about how AI Chatbot works, API Calls, and local models. We will also learn how to use Google AI Studio to prototype apps!
