

Campus Watch - Simple Battery

On Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at 12:36 p.m. the El Camino College Police Department received a report that a male individual approached a female, lifted up her shirt and kissed her waistline. The situation occurred in the Industry & Technology Building, second floor. The individual is described as a male in his 20s, black, sporting a long beard, and wearing a black hoodie and beanie, and gray pants.

El Camino College Police Department Recommendations For Your Safety

- Trust your instincts. If you feel unsafe or uncomfortable in any situation or location, go with your gut it probably isn't the best place to be.
- In the event of an attack, get to a safe place, contact law enforcement immediately, preserve any evidence, and consider the resources available to you through the college, many of which can be found at: www.elcamino.edu/departments/title-ix-diversity-and-inclusion/resources.aspx
- If you see something, say something. By working together we all contribute to the safety of our campus.
- In an emergency, contact Campus Police by calling 911 from a landline phone, 310-660-3100 from a cell phone, or use a campus "Code Blue" emergency phone.
- Have keys in hand before walking to your car.
- Always be aware of your surroundings. Remember the use cell phones may significantly distract you.
- Don't walk alone. Use the buddy system.
- Use ECC Courtesy Shuttle operated by ECC Police; on-call 24 hours. Use one of the police phones located throughout campus or call 310-660-3100.
- Night students and faculty are encouraged to park in the same general area as other faculty or students with night classes in their building. This provides the opportunity for a group of students and faculty to walk together to their cars after dark.
- Immediately report any suspicious activity to campus police.
- Be alert! Be prepared!
