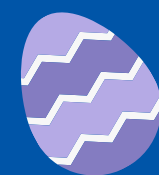

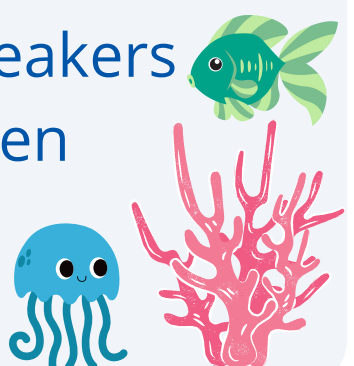
#### Tide Pool Walks
