Enclosed is a **Transfer Presentation Outline** for a Transfer Workshop discussing the **key transfer admission components to UC's and CSU's**





The **Intro to Transfer Workshop** is broken down into 2 parts which can be presented together in a longer format presentation or presented in 2-part series format if preferred.
